**Church of St. Clement at Rodel** is situated at the southern tip of Harris, near Leverburgh. The church was built in the 16th century by Alexander MacLeod of Harris and Dunvegan, otherwise known as Alasdair Crotach (humpback), due to a sword wound. The main features of interest are three tombs carved in black gneiss depicting knights, and the tomb of Alexander (picture to the right). The church is open to the public and run by 'Historic Scotland'.
